

Our Programs

ipolicy

Certificate course on public policy that introduces participants to Comparative Institutional Analysis.

Young Leaders Program

To engage youth with social, economic and political issues through an understanding of public policy within the classical liberal framework that emphasises limited government, rule of law, free trade, and individual rights.

Journalists Program

To equip journalists with objective tools to understand and evaluate policies so as to increase the number and quality of ethical and informed reporting on public policy issues.

Development Leaders

To provide tools that will make them more effective at their work by identifying and evaluating which policies will help or hinder their efforts and formulate and advocate for policies that will complement their organization's vision and goals.

Business Professionals

To develop a greater understanding of the ethical foundations of a market economy and to explore new perspectives and innovative solutions and leverage concepts and tools of sound public policy to make their social change initiatives more impactful.

Government Officials

To help translate policy into practice by offering a step-by step implementation module of policies in education and livelihood sectors.

Our Programs

Freedom Caravan

An internationally recognised month long program that brings young people together to explore ideas about individual liberty and economic prosperity. The program consists of engaging talks, working groups and discussion on a chosen theme in campuses across the country.

Researching Reality Internship

A six week, full time program for students and researchers to provide a greatly valued and needed learning experience in reallifeapplication of social and economic principles and in teaching the skills of research, analysis, writing, and above all critical thinking.

Colloquium

A two-day residential program for in-depth discussion centered on a chosen theme to provide participants an opportunity to reflect on issues of fundamental and enduring importance, share their advanced understandings and to develop innovative ideas and approaches for the advancement of sustainable solutions to policy challenges in India today.
